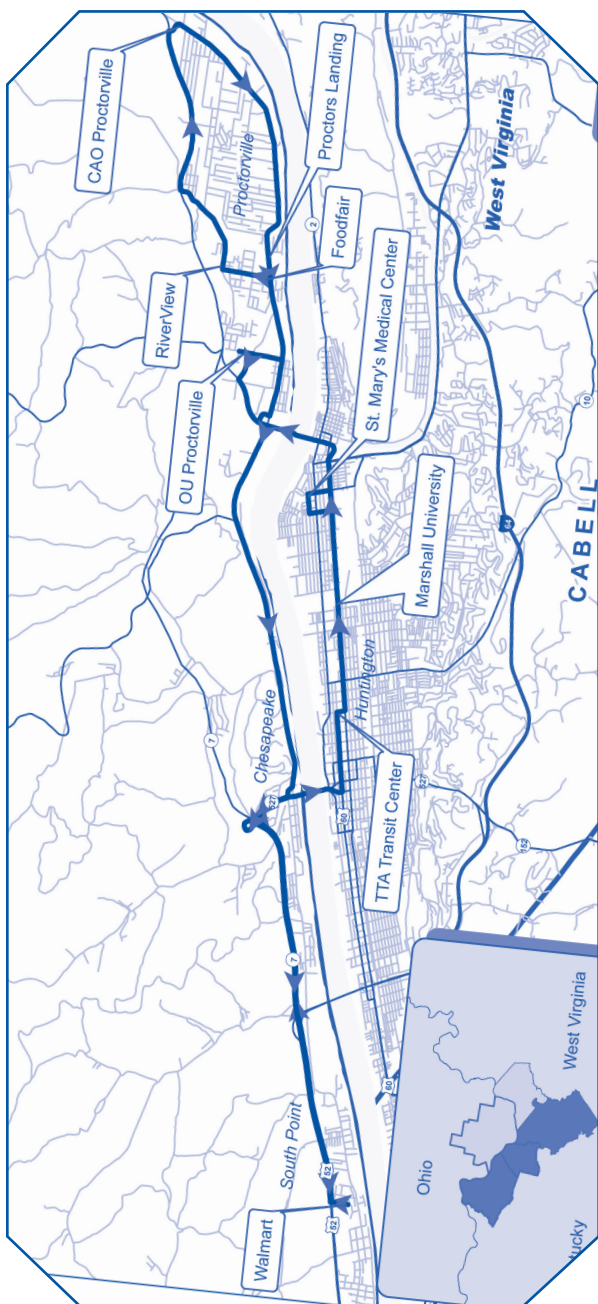

Fares

- For safety, LCT Shuttle drivers do not carry cash.
- Correct change or prepaid pass is required.
- Please have fares, passes or reduced fare cards ready for the driver's inspection upon boarding the shuttle.
- No charge for children 6 and under while riding with an adult.

All Routes

Full Fare \$1.00

Reduced Fare \$.50
(Senior Citizens and persons with disabilities who show a Medicare card qualify for the reduced fare.)

Monthly passes can be purchased at the Ironton Transit Center or Proctor's Landing.

LCT will provide deviated shuttle service for all persons living within 3/4 of a mile of the fixed route with a 24-hour advance notice. For more information, call 740-532-2269.
